### Continuous Thinking Amidst Lingering Uncertainty

More than ever, digital mental health is helping close the treatment gap, improve access to services, and lower costs of treatment to improve the customer journey.

Even before COVID-19 began, consumers had begun acclimating to new technologies that fundamentally change and improve how they live. The pandemic accelerated those changes in a positive way. In **Life Insurance in the Gig Economy**, RGA examines the increasing numbers of traditional workers who are seeking flexibility, and how life insurers are taking notice of this rising and underserved market.

At RGA, we recognize technological advancement and innovation will continue to proliferate even beyond the pandemic, and we will continue to be active leaders in applying medical advancements in the insurance industry. Cancer, for example, will still exist long after the pandemic fades, and there is great potential in researching this and other chronic diseases. 
As 2022 begins, the pandemic remains. However, change is constant, and we look forward to sharing what we've learned.





### SAS-IAAHS Health Conference

The SAS and IAHS organized the Joint SAS-IAAHS Health Conference, themed "Augmented Actuary - Think Global, Act Local" as a hybrid event, hosted on 20-21 September 2021. The conference featured a stellar line up of local and overseas actuaries and health professionals practicing in public and private health. 
